WHEREAS: THE STUDENTS OF MARKETING AND DISTRIBUTIVE EDUCATION HAVE -CHOSEN TO PURSUE CAREERS IN THE FIELDS OF MARKETING, DISTRIBUTION AND MANAGEMENT; AND

WHEREAS: THE WELL-BEING OF OUR CITIZENS DEPENDS ON THE HEALTH OF OUR ECONOMY; AND
