WHEREAS: THE WORD PROCESSING ASSOCIATION OF MINNESOTA, INC., IS SPONSORING THEIR 8TH ANNUAL SYMPOSIUM AND EXHIBITION OF WORD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT AT THE RADISSON ST. Paul on April 21 and 22, 1981; AND
