HEREAS: THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY WOMEN IS THE LARGEST (188,000 MEMBERS AND 900 COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES) AND THE OLDEST NATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF WOMEN, EDUCATION AND LIFELONG LEARNING; AND

HEREAS: MEMBERS OF THE AAUW HAVE BEEN ABLE TO CONTINUE THEIR INTELLECTUAL GROWTH, TO FURTHER THE ADVANCEMENT OF WOMEN AND TO DISCHARGE THEIR SPECIAL RESPONSIBILITIES TO SOCIETY FOR 100 YEARS; AND

HEREAS: AAUW IS CURRENTLY ENGAGED IN AN ALL-OUT ACTION CAMPAIGN FOR WOMEN'S EQUITY CALLED ACTION FOR EQUITY, WHICH IS AN EDUCATIONAL EFFORT TO INCREASE AWARENESS OF THE ISSUES INVOLVED IN ACHIEVING EQUITY FOR WOMEN AND A POLITICAL EFFORT TO WIN RATIFICATION OF THE EQUAL RIGHTS AMENDMENT;


