- EREAS: THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE STUDY OF AFRO-AMERICAN LIFE AND HISTORY WAS FOUNDED IN 1915 BY DR. CHARLES G. WOODSON; AND
- EREAS: THE PURPOSE OF THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE STUDY OF AFRO-AMERICAN LIFE AND HISTORY IS TO CALL ATTENTION TO THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF BLACK PEOPLE TO THE ADVANCEMENT OF AMERICA; AND
- EREAS: THE ASSOCIATION, THROUGH THIS EFFORT, HOPES TO FOSTER BETTER UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN PEOPLE AND TO ENCOURAGE A KEENER APPRECIATION FOR THE HERITAGE OF ALL AMERICAN CITIZENS;

W, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY 1981 TO BE

AFRO-AMERICAN HISTORY MONTH
