WHEREAS: THE PURPOSE OF THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE STUDY OF AFRO-AMERICAN LIFE AND HISTORY IS TO CALL ATTENTION TO THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF BLACK PEOPLE TO THE ADVANCEMENT OF AMERICA; AND


WHEREAS: THE ASSOCIATION, THROUGH THIS EFFORT, HOPES TO FOSTER BETTER UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN PEOPLE AND TO ENCOURAGE A KEENER APPRECIATION FOR THE HERITAGE OF ALL AMERICAN CITIZENS;

AND, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY 1981 TO BE

AFRO-AMERICAN HISTORY MONTH

MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS NINTH DAY OF FEBRUARY OF THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
