- WHEREAS: THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES, DURING THE FIRST WEEK OF FEBRUARY, CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK IS OBSERVED, IN ORDER TO RECOGNIZE THE DEDICATED EFFORTS OF LAY AND RELIGIOUS TEACHERS, PARENTS, ADMINISTRATORS, CLERGY AND STUDENTS WHOSE COMMON STRIVINGS CONTINUE TO MAKE THESE SCHOOLS POSSIBLE, AS WELL AS TO PRODUCE GRADUATES WHO ARE RESPONSIBLE AND CONTRIBUTING MEMBERS OF OUR SOCIETY;
