



Proclamation

HEREAS: IN THE PAST QUARTER CENTURY, OUTSTANDING ADVANCES HAVE BEEN MADE IN SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, COMMUNICATION, AGRICULTURE, COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY IN THE UNITED STATES, CANADA, JAMAICA, BAHAMAS, MEXICO, SURINAM, SA, AND THE CAYMAN ISLANDS; AND

HEREAS: THESE ADVANCEMENTS HAVE CREATED CHALLENGING PROBLEMS FOR MANKIND; AND

HEREAS: THESE CHALLENGES HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED BY INDIVIDUALS AND ORGANIZATIONS SUCH AS CIRCLE K INTERNATIONAL; AND

HEREAS: THE CONCERNED MEMBERS OF CIRCLE K INTERNATIONAL, AN ORGANIZATION OF INVOLVED COLLEGE STUDENTS, SPONSORED BY KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL, ARE PRESENTLY INVOLVED IN SERVICE PROJECTS DESIGNED TO HELP THE LONELY CHILD, THE ABUSED CHILD, AND THE CHILD IN CRISIS UNDER THE THEME "CARING...LIFE'S MAGIC";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 15 THROUGH 21, 1981 TO BE

CIRCLE K WEEK

MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE ALL CITIZENS TO TAKE COGNIZANCE OF THIS EVENTS AND TO APPROPRIATELY PARTICIPATE IN ITS OBSERVANCE.

WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS NINTH DAY OF FEBRUARY THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
