WHEREAS: AMERICANS AND MINNESOTANS OF ALL FAITHS, HAVING HEARD OF THE SEVERE PERSECUTION THAT CHRISTIANS IN THE SOVIET UNION ARE FORCED TO ENDURE, DESIRE TO SEE THIS SITUATION CORRECTED BY A CHANGE OF ATTITUDE ON THE PART OF THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT; AND

WHEREAS: Minnesotans are involved in letter writing campaigns and prayer vigils to help alleviate the suffering of these individuals;

WHEREAS: A RALLY WILL BE HELD ON SATURDAY, MARCH 14, 1981 TO ENCOURAGE STATE-WIDE REMEMBRANCE FOR SOVIET CHRISTIANS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM MARCH 14, 1981 TO BE A

DAY OF REMEMBRANCE

FOR PERSECUTED SOVIET CHRISTIANS, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU HANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.
