WHEREAS: MINNESOTANS ARE INVOLVED IN LETTER WRITING CAMPAIGNS AND PRAYER VIGILS TO HELP ALLEVIATE THE SUFFERING OF THESE INDIVIDUALS; AND






DAY OF REMEMBRANCE

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS NINTH DAY OF FEBRUARY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
