- WHEREAS: CAMP FIRE COUNCILS IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA OFFER OUR YOUNG PEOPLE THE OPPORTUNITY OF INFORMAL EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS, COMBINING GROUP ACTIVITY WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OF INDIVIDUAL TALENTS, IN ADDITION TO FLEXIBLE PROGRAMING TO ENCOURAGE LIFE SKILLS EDUCATION FOR YOUNG PEOPLE UP TO AGE TWENTY-ONE; AND
