



Proclamation

WHEREAS: CANCER IS THE SECOND LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH, AND THIS YEAR THERE WILL BE ABOUT 13,000 NEW CASES AMONG THE MEN, WOMEN AND CHILDREN OF ALL AGES IN MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY PROVIDES INVALUABLE AID IN REHABILITATION SERVICES TO THE CANCER PATIENT, IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF SURVIVAL; AND

WHEREAS: MANY FORMS OF CANCER ARE CURABLE IF DETECTED EARLY AND TREATED PROMPTLY; AND

WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY WILL, DURING THE MONTH OF APRIL, BRING LOCAL CITIZENS IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT CANCER WHICH COULD SAVE OR PROLONG THEIR LIVES; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA DIVISION OF THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY PROVIDES SUPPORT FOR IMPORTANT MEDICAL RESEARCH IN ORDER TO FINALLY ELIMINATE SUFFERING AND DEATH FROM CANCER; AND

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF APRIL 1981 TO BE
