



Proclamation

WHEREAS: MINNESOTANS ARE AVID PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS IN ALL KINDS OF WINTER SPORTS; AND

WHEREAS: HOCKEY IS A FAVORITE MINNESOTA ACTIVITY AND IS ENJOYED YEAR ROUND BY PEOPLE OF ALL AGES; AND

WHEREAS: COLLEGE HOCKEY PLAYS AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN THE LIFE AND VITALITY OF MINNESOTA, REQUIRING TREMENDOUS SKILL AND AGILITY, AND PROVIDING SPIRITED COMPETITION FOR SPECTATORS AND PARTICIPANTS ALIKE; AND

WHEREAS: MINNESOTA WILL BE A CENTER OF COLLEGE HOCKEY ACTIVITY FROM MARCH 26, THROUGH APRIL 1, 1981, WHEN SEVERAL MAJOR COLLEGE HOCKEY EVENTS WILL TAKE PLACE IN OUR STATE; AND

WHEREAS: FROM MARCH 26 THROUGH 28, THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA AT DULUTH WILL HOST THE NCAA HOCKEY CHAMPIONSHIP, DRAWING OUTSTANDING HOCKEY PLAYERS FROM OUR NATION'S COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES TO OUR STATE FOR THREE DAYS OF EXCITING COMPETITION; AND

WHEREAS: ALSO DURING THIS WEEK, THE COLLEGE ALL-STAR GAME WILL BE HELD AT THE MET SPORTS CENTER IN BLOOMINGTON, AND THE FIRST HOBIE BAKER AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED TO OUTSTANDING COLLEGE HOCKEY PLAYERS AT A BANQUET ON APRIL 1; AND
