



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE GREAT STATE OF MINNESOTA IS PROSPEROUS AND THRIVING TODAY DUE TO THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF HORSES; AND

WHEREAS: THE BREED OF HORSE KNOWN AS MORGAN WAS DIRECTLY RESPONSIBLE FOR CIVILIZING THIS LAND; AND

WHEREAS: OUR CALVARY REMOUNT PROGRAM WOULD NOT HAVE SUCCEEDED WITHOUT THE MORGAN INFLUENCE; AND

WHEREAS: THE HORSE INDUSTRY, TO THIS DAY, IS A VITAL SEGMENT OF OUR STATE'S ECONOMY; AND

WHEREAS: THE MORGAN IS THE ONLY REGISTERED BREED OF HORSE EVER PERPETUATED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT; AND

WHEREAS: THE NORTH-CENTRAL MORGAN HORSE ASSOCIATION WILL SPONSOR A WEEK OF MORGAN ACTIVITIES CLIMAXED BY A THREE DAY NORTH STAR MORGAN SHOW, MARKING THE 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE SHOW AND 25 YEARS OF SHOWING THE BEAUTIFUL MORGAN HORSE;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF JULY 6 THROUGH 12, 1981 TO BE
