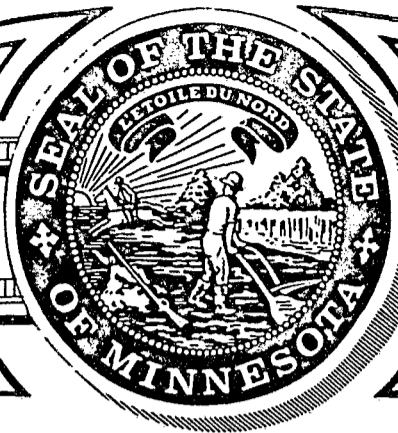


STATE OF MINNESOTA



Proclamation

S: MINNESOTA IS BLESSED WITH DISTINCTIVE AND VIBRANT THEATRE LIFE WHICH ENRICHES THE STATE AND IS ENJOYED BY OUR CITIZENS AND MANY VISITORS; AND

S: THE CHANHASSEN DINNER THEATRES, IN CHANHASSEN, MINNESOTA, HAVE ACHIEVED TREMENDOUS THEATRICAL SUCCESS SINCE BEING FOUNDED IN 1968 BY HERBERT AND CAROL DOMBERG; AND

S: THE PLAY "I DO! I DO!" IS ONE OF THE CHANHASSEN THEATRES' MOST POPULAR AND CELEBRATED PRODUCTIONS, AND HAS EARNED THE ACCLAIM OF CRITICS AND THE LOVE AND DELIGHT OF THE APPROXIMATELY 364,000 PEOPLE WHO HAVE HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO EXPERIENCE IT; AND

S: DAVID ANDERS AND SUSAN GOEPPINGER HAVE PLAYED THE ROLES OF MICHAEL AND AGNES IN "I DO! I DO!" SINCE THE PLAY'S OPENING IN 1971, AND THROUGH THESE ROLES HAVE BECOME A SPECIAL PART OF MINNESOTA LIFE; AND

FURTHER, WE EXTEND OUR SINCERE THANKS AND APPRECIATION FOR ALL DAVID AND SUSAN HAVE GIVEN TO OUR STATE, AND LOOK AHEAD WITH ENTHUSIASM TO THE MONTHS AND YEARS AHEAD AND THE CONTINUED ROLE THEY WILL PLAY IN THE LIFE AND HISTORY OF MINNESOTA.
