WHEREAS: TRANSPORTATION IS A VITAL PART OF OUR SOCIETY; AND

WHEREAS: THE ECONOMIC WELL-BEING OF MINNESOTA DEPENDS UPON THE EXISTANCE OF A VIABLE TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM; AND

WHEREAS: EFFICIENT TRANSPORTATION IS ESSENTIAL TO THE DELIVERY OF OUR PRODUCTS TO MARKET, AND THE FRUITS OF INDUSTRIAL AMERICA TO INDUSTRY AND HOME; AND

WHEREAS: TRANSPORTATION ENRICHES OUR ECONOMY AND STRENGTHENS OUR DEFENSE;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM MAY 15, 1981 TO BE

DEFENSE TRANSPORTATION DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWELFTH DAY OF MARCH IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
