WHEREAS: MAINTENANCE OF THESE STANDARDS AND PROGRESS TOWARDS IMPROVEMENT IN THE QUALITY OF LABORATORY SERVICES DEPENDS UPON THE DEDICATED EFFORTS OF PROFESSIONAL PRACTITIONERS OF LABORATORY SCIENCE; AND



M E D I C A L L A B O R A T O R Y W E E K


