WHEREAS: THE QUALITY OF FOOD THE INDIVIDUAL CONSUMES EACH DAY PLAYS A VITAL ROLE IN HIS HEALTH THROUGHOUT THE LIFE CYCLE; AND

WHEREAS: THERE IS A NEED FOR CONTINUING NUTRITION EDUCATION AND A MASSIVE EFFORT TO ENHANCE FAMILY NUTRITION PRACTICES;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA,

DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF MARCH 1981 TO BE

NUTRITION MONTH

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.
