WHEREAS, a certain petition dated April 1, 1980, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 7th day of April, 1980, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 10.2 acres more or less of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city or statutory city, and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by the sole fee owners, and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board or the governing body of any municipality whose boundries abut upon the boundries of the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts on the city limits at the Easterly boundry thereof, the Council of the City of Big Lake, Minnesota ordains.


