Farmington

An Ordinance amending the City Code concerning City Boundaries and changes thereto by annexation.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I Title 1, Chapter 11, Section 2(A) of the City Code is hereby amended by adding the following:

- "14. Upon receipt of petition for annexation of Robert A. and Jeannine Erickson, fee owners, dated April 7, 1980 and upon receipt of approval and waiver by the Empire Town Board dated April 10, 1980, under Minnesota Municipal Board Docket No. A-3693, the following described lands are hereby annexed to and become a part of the municipality of Farmington:

Commencing at a point 290.4 feet east of the west line of 5th Street extended in the City of Farmington and 150 feet north of the south line of Section 30, Township 114, Range 19; thence south and parallel with the west line of 5th Street extended a distance of 128 feet; thence west parallel with the south line of said Section 30 a distance of 4.9 feet; thence deflecting to the right along a curve with a central angle of $16^{\circ}20'$ and a radius of 263.03 feet a distance of 74.98 feet to the left on a curve with a central angle of $2^{\circ}18'51.76''$ and a radius of 12.4 feet; thence to the left on a curve with a central angle of $14^{\circ}01'08.24''$ and a radius of 75.12 feet; thence with the south line of Section 30 a distance of 117.02 feet; thence north along the south line of 5th Street extended a distance of 105 feet; thence east along a line parallel to the south line of Section 30 a distance of 290.4 feet which is the point of beginning."
