WHEREAS: THE DAFFODIL, AS THE FIRST FLOWER OF SPRING, IS SYMBOLIC OF NEW LIFE; AND

WHEREAS: THIS SYMBOL OF NEW LIFE HAS ALSO BEEN ADOPTED BY THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY AS THE SYMBOL OF HOPE FOR PEOPLE LIVING WITH CANCER; AND

WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY WILL DISTRIBUTE 580,000 DAFFODILS IN MINNESOTA ON APRIL 3, 4, AND 5, 1981, TO PROMOTE AWARENESS OF CANCER PREVENTION AND TREATMENT; AND

WHEREAS: THE ADVANCES IN CANCER RESEARCH AND TREATMENT HAVE SAVED LIVES AND GIVEN NEW HOPE TO THOUSANDS OF MINNESOTANS; AND






