

Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE FUNDAMENTAL FREEDOMS OF THE CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA, AND THEIR FELLOW AMERICANS, ARE EMBODIED IN THE CONCEPT OF "PRIVATE PROPERTY RIGHTS - PROTECT THEM"; AND

- WHEREAS: IN THE ENTIRE AMERICAN FREE ENTERPRISE SYSTEM, THIS CONCEPT IS PERHAPS NOWHERE MORE PERSONALLY MEANINGFUL THAN IN THE RIGHT OF EVERY CITIZEN TO OWN REAL PROPERTY; AND
- WHEREAS: IT IS ONLY BY SUSTAINING THE LAND AND PERPETUATING OUR CONSTITU-TIONAL RIGHTS TO IT THAT EACH OF US CAN CONTINUE TO ENJOY ITS BOUNTY AND ENSURE THE SAME PRIVILEGES FOR GENERATIONS TO COME; AND
- WHEREAS: THE FULFILLMENT OF THIS OBLIGATION IS DEMONSTRATED BY THE COMMIT-MENT AND CONCERN OF THE MINNESOTA ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS IN ASSISTING MINNESOTA RESIDENTS WHO WISH TO EXERCISE THEIR RIGHT TO OWN PROPERTY; AND
- WHEREAS: NATIONWIDE, SINCE 1956, REALTORS HAVE PARTICIPATED IN PRIVATE PROPERTY WEEK AS A SPECIAL TIME TO REMIND AMERICANS OF OUR RIGHT TO OWN PROPERTY, AND OUR INDIVIDUAL RESPONSIBILITY TO GUARD THIS RIGHT FROM ANY INFRINGEMENT, PERSONAL OR POLITICAL;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF APRIL 19 THROUGH 25, 1981 TO BE

PRIVATE PROPERTY WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME, FURTHER, I URGE MINNESOTANS TO JOIN WITH THE MINNESOTA ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS DURING THIS OBSERVANCE.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-SIXTH DAY OF MARCH IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
