WHEREAS: SPORT FISHING PROVIDES HEALTHFUL RECREATION FOR MORE THAN SIXTY MILLION AMERICANS OF ALL AGES; AND

WHEREAS: FISHING PROMOTES RESPECT FOR OUR NATION'S NATURAL WATERS, WILDERNESS AND WILDLIFE; AND

WHEREAS: FISHING IS AN ESTABLISHED RECREATIONAL TRADITION ROOTED DEEPLY IN THE HISTORY OF OUR COUNTRY AND THE HEARTS OF OUR CITIZENS; AND

WHEREAS: SPORT FISHING SUPPORTS A BILLION DOLLAR INDUSTRY AND PROVIDES EMPLOYMENT FOR MILLIONS OF PERSONS; AND

WHEREAS: Sport fishing, through the payment of millions of dollars annually for licenses, taxes and fees, has provided the funding for federal and state programs that contribute significantly to the preservation and protection of our natural environment;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF MAY 11 THROUGH 17, 1981 TO BE
