WHEREAS: RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS (ROTC) PROGRAMS PROVIDE PARTICIPANTS WITH EXCELLENT TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE IN LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT, AND FOSTER A SENSE OF SERVICE TO COUNTRY; AND

WHEREAS: ROTC graduates from the State of Minnesota serve with dedication AND DISTINCTION AS MEMBERS OF OUR ARMED FORCES, AND CARRY WITH THEM VALUABLE ABILITIES THAT MAKE THEM LEADERS IN OTHER PROFESSIONAL AND COMMUNITY SETTINGS, AS WELL;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM MAY 2, 1981 TO BE

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA DO BE AFFIXED THIS NINTH DAY OF APRIL IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
