

Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE LIVESTOCK INDUSTRY IS VITAL TO THE LIVES OF ALL MINNESOTANS AND IS THE DOMINANT SHARE OF THIS STATE'S FARM ECONOMY; AND

- WHEREAS: THE SAINT PAUL UNION STOCKYARDS IN SOUTH SAINT PAUL HAVE LONG CONTRIBUTED TO THIS IMPORTANT INDUSTRY BY MAINTAINING A COMPLETE AND COMPETITIVE LIVESTOCK MARKETING FACILITY; AND
- WHEREAS: For the seventh consecutive year, Minnesota's Saint Paul Union Stockyards is the World's Largest Volume Livestock Market, providing farm producers in the Upper Midwest and neighboring Canada the highest possible returns on their investment; and
- WHEREAS: ON APRIL 7, 1981, THE CONTINUING ACHIEVEMENTS OF THIS WORLD LEADING FACILITY WILL BE EMPHASIZED AT THE 34TH ANNUAL MEETING OF THE SOUTH SAINT PAUL LIVESTOCK MARKET INSTITUTE;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM APRIL 7, 1981 TO BE

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE ALL CITIZENS TO JOIN IN APPRECIATION FOR THIS STATE'S LIVESTOCK PRODUCING AND MARKETING INDUSTRY AND FOR THE SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY THE SAINT PAUL UNION STOCKYARDS.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS EIGHTEENTH DAY OF MARCH IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
