



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE WACONIA HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND, OF WACONIA, MINNESOTA, HAS BEEN SELECTED AS ONE OF THE OUTSTANDING MUSICAL UNITS OF OUR STATE AND HAS ACCEPTED AN INVITATION TO REPRESENT THE STATE OF MINNESOTA AT THE FESTIVAL OF STATES IN ST. PETERSBURG, FLORIDA, WHICH WILL BE HELD FROM MARCH 23 THROUGH APRIL 5, 1981; AND

WHEREAS: THE WACONIA HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND HAS LONG BEEN A SYMBOL OF SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE IN MARCHING AND MUSIC, AND HAS EARNED A REPUTATION FOR DEVELOPING IN ITS YOUNG PEOPLE CHARACTER, DISCIPLINE, COOPERATION, AND A DEEP APPRECIATION FOR THE JOYS OF MUSIC; AND

WHEREAS: UNDER THE DIRECTION OF JIM THULIEN, THE WACONIA HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND PROMISES TO REPRESENT OUR STATE WITH DISTINCTION AND COMPETENCE IN FLORIDA, AND IN ALL ITS PERFORMANCES WITHIN AND OUTSIDE OF MINNESOTA'S BORDERS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY DESIGNATE

AT THE FESTIVAL OF STATES CELEBRATION IN ST. PETERSBURG, FLORIDA. FURTHER, ONE BEHALF OF THE CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA, AND THROUGH THE GOODWILL OF THE WACONIA HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND, I EXTEND BEST WISHES TO THE PEOPLE OF THE GREAT STATE OF FLORIDA.
