WHEREAS: THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA ARE GRATEFUL TO THE MINNESOTA HUMANE Society for the contributions they have made in educating citizens in humane principles and promoting a spirit of kindness and consideration for animals in the minds and hearts of our citizens; and

WHEREAS: THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA RECOGNIZE THE VALUE OF TEACHING KINDNESS TO OUR YOUNG PEOPLE THROUGH HUMANE EDUCATION AND REALIZE THAT OUT OF KINDNESS TO ANIMALS GROWS KINDNESS AND LOVE FOR ALL HUMANITY;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF MAY 3 THROUGH 9, 1981 TO BE
