NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H, QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA,
DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF MAY 18 THROUGH 23, 1981 TO BE

LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSES WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO RECOGNIZE THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSES.
