WHEREAS: The well-being of the people of Minnesota depends upon the production of ample supplies of food, fiber and other products of the soil; and

WHEREAS: THE QUALITY AND QUANTITY OF THESE PRODUCTS DEPENDS UPON THE CONSERVATION AND WISE AND PROPER MANAGEMENT OF OUR SOIL AND WATER RESOURCES; AND

WHEREAS: THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA SHARE A LOVE FOR THE LAND AND A DEEP SENSE OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR PRESERVING ITS PRODUCTIVITY; AND

WHEREAS: Conservation districts provide a practical and democratic organization through which landowners are taking the initiative to conserve and make proper use of these resources; and

WHEREAS: These conservation districts are carrying forward a program of soil and water conservation in cooperation with numerous agencies and countless individuals;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF MAY 24 THROUGH 31, 1981 TO BE

SOIL STEWARDSHIP WEEK
