WHEREAS: American Youth Hostels, Inc., has provided services to young people from American and abroad, and has helped make it possible for millions of people to experience the heritage and beauty of our nation; and

WHEREAS: AYH was founded in 1934 by Isabel Smith and her late husband, Monroe, in Northfield, Massachusetts, and is now affiliated with International Youth Hostel Federation, which has a world-wide membership of 3.1 million and reported 30 million overnights last year; and

WHEREAS: During the week of May 3 through 9, special events will be held throughout the country, including two of the most celebrated national bike events, the 6th annual 5 Boro Bike Tour in New York City, and the 20th annual TOSRV in Ohio;
