

Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE U.S. Army Reserve is essential to the strength of the United States and to the defense of our democratic society; and

WHEREAS: THE CITIZENS SERVING IN THE U.S. ARMY RESERVE HAVE CHOSEN TO DEDICATE THEMSELVES TO THEIR NATION'S DEFENSE AND TO MAKING THEIR COMMUNITIES A BETTER PLACE IN WHICH TO LIVE; AND

WHEREAS: Over 3,500 citizens of the State of Minnesota are active members of the 45 units of the 88th U.S. Army Reserve Command or have served in the U.S. Army Reserve at some time during their lives; and

WHEREAS: These citizens have applied their military skills to assist in community projects and activities with the same sense of responsibility and dedication with which they serve their nation:
