

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Young People who have Dropped out of school before completing their high school education often require unique assistance to obtain challenging and satisfying employment; and

WHEREAS: THE BENEFITS OF ENHANCING THE MOTIVATION, SELF-IMAGE AND PRODUCTIVITY OF THIS SEGMENT OF OUR SOCIETY ARE CONSIDERABLE, BOTH IN ECONOMIC AND HUMAN TERMS; AND

WHEREAS: EXCEL-LIFE SKILLS IS A PROGRAM FOR UNEMPLOYED, OUT-OF-SCHOOL YOUTH BETWEEN THE AGES OF SIXTEEN AND TWENTY-TWO, WHICH HELPS PARTICIPANTS GAIN EMPLOYMENT AND IMPROVE THEIR PERSONAL SKILLS, MOTIVATION AND SELF-CONFIDENCE WHILE STIMULATING THEIR DESIRE TO OBTAIN ADDITIONAL EDUCATIONAL AND SOCIAL COMPETENCIES; AND

WHEREAS: EXCEL HAS SPAWNED A YOUTH ORGANIZATION, LIFE SKILLS, WHICH SERVES THE SPECIFIC MOTIVATIONAL AND EDUCATIONAL NEEDS OF HIGH SCHOOL DROPOUTS, AND RECOGNIZES THEIR POSITIVE ECONOMIC, EDUCATIONAL AND SOCIAL ACHIEVEMENTS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA,
DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF MAY 1981 TO BE

EXCEL-LIFE SKILLS MONTH
