

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Coins and currency form a universal part of the lives of all PEOPLE: AND

WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN NUMISMATIC ASSOCIATION, A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION FOUNDED IN 1891 AND CHARTERED BY A SPECIAL ACT OF CONGRESS IN 1912, IS OBSERVING THE WEEK OF APRIL 19 THROUGH 25, 1981 AS NATIONAL COIN WEEK: AND

WHEREAS: CURRENCY HAS RECORDED SIGNIFICANT EVENTS, FROM THE RISE AND FALL OF REPUBLICS TO THE WORLD'S GREATEST ACCOMPLISHMENTS, AND HAS SYMBOLICALLY PRESENTED MAN'S HIGHEST IDEALS; AND

WHEREAS: Members of the American Numismatic Association and kindred ASSOCIATIONS ENCOURAGE AND PROMOTE EDUCATIONAL AND FRATERNAL RELATIONS AND FOSTER THE INTEREST OF ALL AGES IN A SUBJECT THAT IS ENTERTAINING AND INSTRUCTIVE;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA. DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF APRIL 19 THROUGH 25, 1981 TO BE

NATIONAL COIN WEEK

ASKED LIEUTENANT MINNESOTA, AND HAVE GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, We have hereunto set our hands and caused the Great SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-SECOND DAY OF APRIL IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND,
