

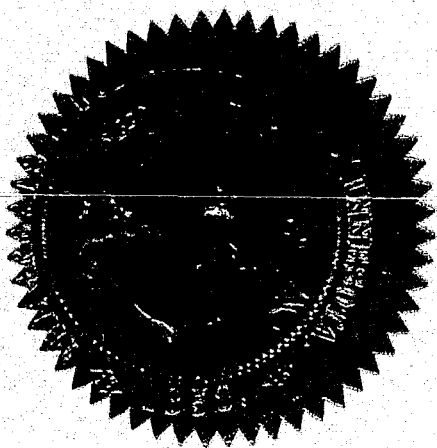

PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, Mary Nisa Karish, an aged resident of Biwabik, St. Louis County, was brutally murdered and her son seriously injured, by four men who entered their home in the night of July 21, 1925, and attacked them with axes; and,

WHEREAS, The persons who murdered the said Mary Nisa Karish have not been apprehended, and public welfare and the ends of justice demand that they be apprehended and punished accordingly to law;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Theodore Christianson, Governor of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State of Minnesota, the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS, for the arrest and conviction, or for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the guilty persons, and a proportionate sum for any one of the parties who may be found legally responsible for the killing of the said Mary Nisa Karish.
