ORDER

On September 17, 1980, the Minnesota Municipal Board received a petition by all of the property owners for the detachment of certain land described herein from the City of Wilmont. A resolution for the detachment of the same land was not received from the City of Wilmont.

The matter came on for hearing before the Minnesota Municipal Board pursuant to M.S. 414, as amended, on November 25, 1980 and was conducted by Thomas J. Simmons, Chairman. Testimony was heard and records and exhibits were received. The record was left open for the receipt of a city ordinance establishing a rural-urban taxing district if such ordinance was adopted.

On March 6, 1981 the Minnesota Municipal Board received an ordinance dividing the area within the limits of the City of Wilmont into an urban service taxing district and a rural service taxing district.

On April 29, 1981, the Municipal Board received request from the petitioners to withdraw their petition for detachment because the City of Wilmont had adopted an urban-rural taxing district ordinance.

After due and careful consideration of all evidence, together with all records, files and proceedings, the Municipal Board makes the following order,

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the petition for the detachment of the following described property from the City of Wilmont is hereby withdrawn.

The Northwest one-fourth of the Northeast one-fourth
Section 1, Township 103, North, Range 42 West from the
City of Wilmont, Nobles County, Minnesota.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is May 1, 1981. and Minnesota Municipal Board file docket D-152 is hereby closed.
