WHEREAS: MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS ARE NUTRITIOUS AND SATISFYING TO MINNESOTANS OF ALL AGES; AND

WHEREAS: THE DAIRY INDUSTRY IS AN IMPORTANT SEGMENT OF OUR STATE'S FARM ECONOMY, AND THE DAILY WORK AND DEDICATION OF THOSE WHO PRODUCE AND PROCESS OUR DAIRY PRODUCTS CONTRIBUTES GREATLY TO OUR WELL-BEING; AND

WHEREAS: June, the month celebrated by Minnesotans as the start of our state's glorious summer season, is a time when the convenient and refreshing aspects of dairy foods and the efforts of those who work to assure their supply are particularly appreciated;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF JUNE, 1981 TO BE
