WHEREAS: DURING THE PAST 59 YEARS, SHRINER HOSPITALS HAVE CURED OR MATERIALLY HELPED MORE THAN 250,000 CHILDREN; AND

WHEREAS: SHRINER HOSPITALS FOR CRIPPLED CHILDREN AND BURN INSTITUES DESERVE APPRECIATION FOR GREAT HUMANITARIAN WORK;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM JUNE 14, 1981 TO BE

INTERNATIONAL SHRINE HOSPITAL DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT .SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF MAY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
