ORDINANCE NO. 2--SECOND SERIES

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WINDOM, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY BORDERED BY LAND WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS AND ABUTTING THEREON:

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated City, Village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, on March 30, 1979, notice of Petition for Annexation of said territory was duly served upon the Town Board of Great Bend Township; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the City limits at the North and West boundary thereof:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WINDOM, MINNESOTA AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interest of the City and to the territory affected and that none of the territory is now included within the corporate limits of any other City, Village or Borough, and that the territory described herein abuts upon the City Limits and is urban or suburban in character.
- 2. The corporate limits of the City of Windom, Minnesota are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory in Great Bend Township, Cottonwood County, Minnesota as follows:

A TRACT OF LAND BEING PART OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER (SW1) OF THE SOUTH-EAST QUARTER (SE1) OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE1) OF SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 105 NORTH, RANGE 36 WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN IN COTTONWOOD COUNTY, MINNESOTA, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the SW\$ of the SE\$ of the NE\$ of said Section 22, thence Southerly, along the West line of the SW\$ of the SW\$ OF THE NE\$ OF SAID SECTION 22, A DISTANCE OF 326.00 feet; thence Easterly, along a line parallel with the North line of the SW\$ of the SE\$ of the NE\$ of said Section 22, a distance of 180.00 feet; thence Northerly along a line parallel with the West line of the SW\$ of the SE\$ of the NE\$ of said Section 22, a distance of 326.00 feet, to the North line of the SW\$ of the SE\$ of the NE\$ of said Section 22; thence West, along said North line, a distance of 180.00 feet, to the point of beginning. Said tract containing 1.35 acres.


