



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE HISTORY OF MINNESOTA IS A FASCINATING STORY OF PEOPLE FROM EVERY CORNER OF THE WORLD COMING TOGETHER TO LIVE AND WORK; AND

WHEREAS: THE COMMON INTERESTS OF ALL MINNESOTANS IN THE ECONOMIC AND CULTURAL VITALITY OF THEIR STATE ARE COMPLIMENTED BY THE DESIRE OF MANY TO ACTIVELY MAINTAIN TIES WITH THEIR ETHNIC HERITAGE; AND

WHEREAS: THE IRON RANGE INTERPRETATIVE CENTER WILL BE CELEBRATING THE FOURTH ANNUAL MINNESOTA ETHNIC DAYS DURING THE PERIOD FROM JULY 22 THROUGH AUGUST 2, 1981; AND

WHEREAS: THE CENTER WILL CELEBRATE MINNESOTA'S RICH HERITAGE BY DEVELOPING A THEME EACH DAY, HIGHLIGHTING THE MUSIC, FOOD, ARTS AND CRAFTS, COSTUMES AND LIFESTYLES OF SPECIFIC ETHNIC GROUPS, INCLUDING ENTERTAINMENT EACH DAY IN THE AFTERNOON AND EVENING;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM JULY 22 THROUGH AUGUST 2, 1981 TO BE

ETHNIC DAYS

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME,

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FOURTH DAY OF JUNE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD,
