



Proclamation

WHEREAS: FATHERS RENDER VALUABLE SERVICES TO EVERY FIELD OF EFFORT WHICH IS NECESSARY FOR THE PROSPERITY AND HEALTH OF OUR NATION AND STATE; AND

WHEREAS: WE LOOK TO THE FATHER IN THE HOME AS A VITAL PARTNER IN RAISING CHILDREN AND FOSTERING IN THEM THE IMPORTANCE OF THE MORALS AND ETHICS WHICH GOVERN RELATIONSHIPS AMONG ALL PEOPLE, AND TO IMPRESS UPON THEM THE VALUE OF CIVIC INVOLVEMENT AND RESPONSIBILITY, WHICH ARE THE RESULTS OF GOOD AMERICAN CITIZENSHIP; AND

WHEREAS: IT IS APPROPRIATE THAT WE DESIGNATE ONE DAY IN THE YEAR TO TRIBUTE TO FATHERS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SUNDAY, JUNE 21, 1981 TO BE

FATHER'S DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO ENFORCE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. I URGE CITIZENS TO HONOR THE FATHER IN THE HOME ON THIS DAY AND ALL DAY OF THE YEAR.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FOURTH DAY OF JUNE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
