



Proclamation

WHEREAS: FATHERS RENDER VALUABLE SERVICES TO EVERY FIELD OF LIFE WHICH IS NECESSARY FOR THE PROSPERITY AND HEALTH OF OUR NATION STATE; AND

WHEREAS: WE LOOK TO THE FATHER IN THE HOME AS A VITAL PARTNER IN RAISING CHILDREN AND FOSTERING IN THEM THE IMPORTANCE OF THE MORALS AND ETHICS WHICH GOVERN RELATIONSHIPS AMONG ALL PEOPLE, AND TO IMPRESS UPON THE VALUE OF CIVIC INVOLVEMENT AND RESPONSIBILITY, WHICH ARE THE MARKS OF GOOD AMERICAN CITIZENSHIP; AND

WHEREAS: IT IS APPROPRIATE THAT WE DESIGNATE ONE DAY IN THE YEAR TO HONOR AND TRIBUTE TO FATHERS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SUNDAY, JUNE 21, 1981 TO BE

FATHER'S DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO SIGN THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. I ENCOURAGE I URGE CITIZENS TO HONOR THE FATHER IN THE HOME ON THIS DAY
