



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THROUGHOUT THE HISTORY OF THE UNITED STATES, THE FLYING OF OUR NATIONAL FLAG HAS SERVED AS A SYMBOL OF LIBERTY, FREEDOM AND JUSTICE; AND

WHEREAS: JUNE 14 HAS BEEN RECOGNIZED AS A DAY OF SPECIAL RECOGNITION OF THIS PRIVILEGE AND HAS BEEN OBSERVED THROUGHOUT THE NATION WITH THE FLYING OF THE AMERICAN FLAG; AND

WHEREAS: THIS DAY PROVIDES THE OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL CITIZENS TO DISPLAY THE FLAG ON HOMES AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS AS A REAFFIRMATION OF THEIR PRIDE AND COMMITMENT TO THE PRINCIPLES OF THIS NATION; AND

WHEREAS: FLYING THE FLAG SHOULD ALSO SERVE AS A REMINDER OF THE DEDICATION AND SACRIFICE OF THOSE MEN AND WOMEN WHO COMMITTED THEMSELVES TO THE DEFENSE OF OUR COUNTRY'S FREEDOM AND HONOR;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SUNDAY, JUNE 14, 1981 TO BE

FLAG DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS OBSERVANCE THROUGH APPROPRIATE CEREMONIES AND ACTIVITIES.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FOURTH DAY OF JUNE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
