

## Proclamation

WHILAS: THROUCHOUT THE HISTORY OF THE UNITED STATES, THE FLYING OF OUR MATIONAL FLAG HAS SERVED AS A SYMBOL OF LILERTY, FREEDOM AND JUSTICE; AND

- WHISEAS: JUNE 14 HAS BEEN RECOGNIZED AS A DAY OF SPECIAL RECOGNITION OF THIS PRIVILEGE AND HAS BEEN OBSERVED THROUGHOUT THE NATION WITH THE FLYING OF THE AMERICAN FLAG; AND
- WEEREAS: THIS DAY PROVIDES THE OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL CITIZENS TO DISPLAY THE FLAG ON HOMES AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS AS A REAFFIRMATION OF THEIR FRIDE AND COMMITMENT TO THE PRINCIPLES OF THIS NATION; AND
- Where AS: Flying the flag should also serve as a reminder of the dedication and sacrifice of those men and women who committed themselves to the backing of our country's freedom and honor;

NGU, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SUNDAY, JUNE 14, 1981 TO BE

I MARKESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS OBSERVANCE THROUGH APPROPRIATE CEREMONIES AND ACTVITIES.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FOURTH DAY OF JUNE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD,
