

Proclamation

WHEREAS: AGRICULTURE PLAYS A CENTRAL ROLE IN MINNESOTA'S ECONOMY; AND

WHEREAS: LIVESTOCK IS A DOMINANT SHARE OF MINNESOTA'S FARM ECONOMY; AND

WHEREAS: THE MARKETING OF MINNESOTA'S FARM PRODUCTS REQUIRES KNOWLEDGEABLE AND OFTEN DIFFICULT DECISIONS; AND

WHEREAS: PRODUCERS ARE CONSTANTLY STRIVING FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN PRESENT MARKETING TECHNIQUES AND INFORMATION ON NEW METHODS AND DEVELOPMENTS; AND

WHEREAS: MINNESOTA IS THE SITE OF THE LIVESTOCK MARKETING CONGRESS, JUNE 10-12, 1981, WHERE THE IMPORTANCE OF ALL MARKETING DECISIONS WILL BE DISCUSSED;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM JUNE 10 THROUGH 12, 1981 TO BE

LIVESTOCK MARKETING DAYS

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.
