



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE WOMEN'S DIVISION OF THE NATIONAL SAFETY COUNCIL REPRESENTS SOME 60 VOLUNTEER MEMBERS AT LARGE AND 68 NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S ORGANIZATIONS WHICH ACT FOR MORE THAN 58 MILLION WOMEN; AND

WHEREAS: THE WOMEN'S DIVISION OF THE NATIONAL SAFETY COUNCIL RECOGNIZES THE NEED FOR, AND INITIATES, "MAKE IT CLICK - BUCKLE UP", A PROGRAM TO ENLIST THE SUPPORT OF THIS NATION'S WOMEN TO GET MORE AMERICANS TO USE OCCUPANT RESTRAINTS; AND

WHEREAS: "MAKE IT CLICK - BUCKLE UP" WILL ASK VOLUNTEERS TO SIGN CARDS PLEDGING THAT THEY AND THEIR MOTOR VEHICLE OCCUPANTS WILL USE SAFETY RESTRAINTS EACH TIME THEY ARE IN A VEHICLE;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF AUGUST 1981 TO BE

MAKE IT CLICK - BUCKLE UP MONTH

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME, IN RECOGNITION OF THE OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY VOLUNTEER WOMEN, UNITED TO SAVE LIVES AND PREVENT INJURIES BY ENCOURAGING EVERYONE TO BUCKLE UP!

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIFTH DAY OF JUNE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
