WHEREAS: THERE IS A DEEP CONCERN IN OUR NATION AND STATE OVER THE DRAMATIC INCIDENCE OF CANCER AND THE MANY DEATHS THIS DREAD DISEASE CAUSES EACH YEAR; AND

WHEREAS: DEMOGRAPHIC TRENDS SUGGEST THAT DEATHS FROM CANCER MAY NUMBER EIGHT MILLION ANNUALLY BY THE YEAR 2000, ACCORDING TO THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION REPORT; AND

WHEREAS: EARLY DETECTION AND TREATMENT OF CANCER COULD RESULT IN THE SAVING OF MILLIONS OF LIVES EACH YEAR;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SEPTEMBER 8, 1981 TO BE

### NATIONAL CANCER DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME,

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FOURTH DAY OF JUNE OF THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
