

## Proclamation

WHIFEAS: CHILDREN ARE OUR GREATEST NATURAL RESOURCE, AND BURNS CLAIM THE LIVES OF MORE PRE-SCHOOLER'S THAN ANY INFECTIOUS DISEASE; AND

WHEREAS: More than two million burn injuries occur in North America each year, most of these involving children under the age of ten; and

WHEREAS: Experience has taught us that the Best treatment of a Burn is prevention, and seventy-five percent of the Burns that occur today are preventable; and

WHEREAS: THE SHRINE OF NORTH AMERICA, LEADERS IN THE FIELD OF CHILDREN'S ORTHOPEDIC CARE AND BURN TREATMENT, OPERATES A NETWORK OF TWENTY-ONE HOSPITALS THROUGHOUT NORTH AMERICA WHERE MEDICAL CARE IS PROVIDED FREE OF CHARGE, REGARDLESS OF RACE, RELIGION OR RELATIONSHIP TO A SHRINER; AND

WHEREAS: THE SHRINERS HAVE IDENTIFIED A MOUNTING BURN PROBLEM AND HAVE LAUNCHED A NATIONAL "STOP BURN INJURIES" CAMPAIGN:

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-FIFTH DAY OF JUNE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
