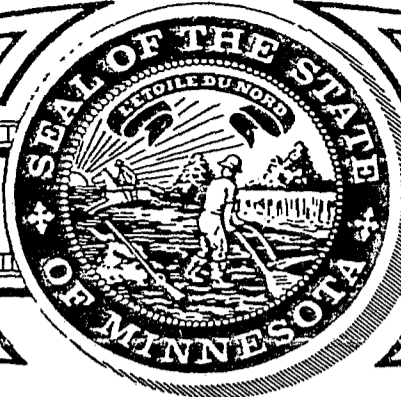


STATE OF MINNESOTA



Proclamation

WHEREAS: MINNESOTA IS FORTUNATE TO BE THE HOME OF A GREAT NUMBER OF OUTSTANDING ORGANIZATIONS DEDICATED TO THE PERFORMANCE, ENHANCEMENT AND ENCOURAGEMENT OF THE ARTS; AND

WHEREAS: IT IS BENEFICIAL FOR ALL CITIZENS TO BE OFFERED THE OPPORTUNITY TO ENJOY THE VARIETY OF ARTS ACTIVITIES IN OUR STATE; AND

WHEREAS: FOR THE SECOND TIME IN THE TWIN CITIES, APPROXIMATELY TWENTY-FIVE ARTS ORGANIZATIONS WILL BE PARTICIPATING IN AN OUT-REACH PROGRAM IN METROPOLITAN AREA SHOPPING CENTERS, AS A MEANS TO BRING THE ARTS TO A WIDER CROSS-SECTION OF PEOPLE; AND

WHEREAS: THESE TWENTY-FIVE CULTURAL GROUPS ARE EAGER TO CREATE EXCITEMENT AND ENTHUSIASM IN HOPES OF INFORMING CITIZENS OF ACTIVITIES THEY MAY NOT HAVE BEEN AWARE OF, AND IN WHICH THEY MAY WISH TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FUTURE; AND

WHEREAS: THIS PROGRAM, RUNNING FROM JULY 31 THROUGH AUGUST 9, 1981, INCLUDES PERFORMANCES AND DEMONSTRATIONS OF DANCE, ACTING, MIME, SINGING, POETRY, PUPPETRY, CRAFTS AND FILM; AND

WHEREAS: THIS "ARTS ALIVE!" CELEBRATION IS A UNIQUE JOINING TOGETHER OF MINNESOTA'S ARTS COMMUNITY TO PRESENT A PROGRAM OF ENTERTAINMENT FOR THE PURPOSES OF INFORMING, EDUCATING AND DELIGHTING CITIZENS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM JULY 31 THROUGH AUGUST 9, 1981 TO BE

ARTS ALIVE DAYS

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS NINTH DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
