WHEREAS: THE UNITED STATES HAS NEVER BEEN, AND WILL NEVER BE, GREATER THAN THE EXERTION AND IDEALISM OF HER CITIZENS; AND

WHEREAS: OUR NATION HAS FOUNDED ITS INSTITUTIONS AND NURTURED THEIR PROGRESS ON THE WILLINGNESS OF ITS PEOPLE TO SERVE THE COMMON GOOD; AND

WHEREAS: THIS SPIRIT OF SERVICE ENABLES US TO STRIVE TOWARD A SOCIETY IN WHICH OUR RESPECT FOR EACH OTHER WILL GROW, AS WE MANIFEST MORE AND MORE CONCERN FOR EACH OTHER'S RIGHTS AND WELL-BEING;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF JULY 6 THROUGH JULY 10, 1981 TO BE

PUBLIC SERVICE WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME,

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS NINTH DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
