NOW, THEREFORE, I! ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF JULY 6 THROUGH JULY 10, 1981 TO BE

PUBLIC SERVICE WEEK
