WHEREAS: MINNESOTANS ARE ENTHUSIASTIC PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS IN A WIDE VARIETY OF SPORTS AND ATHLETIC ENDEAVORS; AND

WHEREAS: AMONG THE MOST POPULAR SPORTS IN MINNESOTA IS THAT OF SOCCER; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA SOCCER ASSOCIATION IS AN ACTIVE ORGANIZATION, DEDICATED TO PROMOTING AND ENHANCING THE GAME OF SOCCER IN OUR STATE; AND

WHEREAS: MINNESOTA HAS BEEN SELECTED TO HOST THE U. S. SOCCER FEDERATION REGION II SOCCER TOURNAMENT, WHICH WILL BE HELD JULY 17 THROUGH 19; AND



IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS NINTH DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
